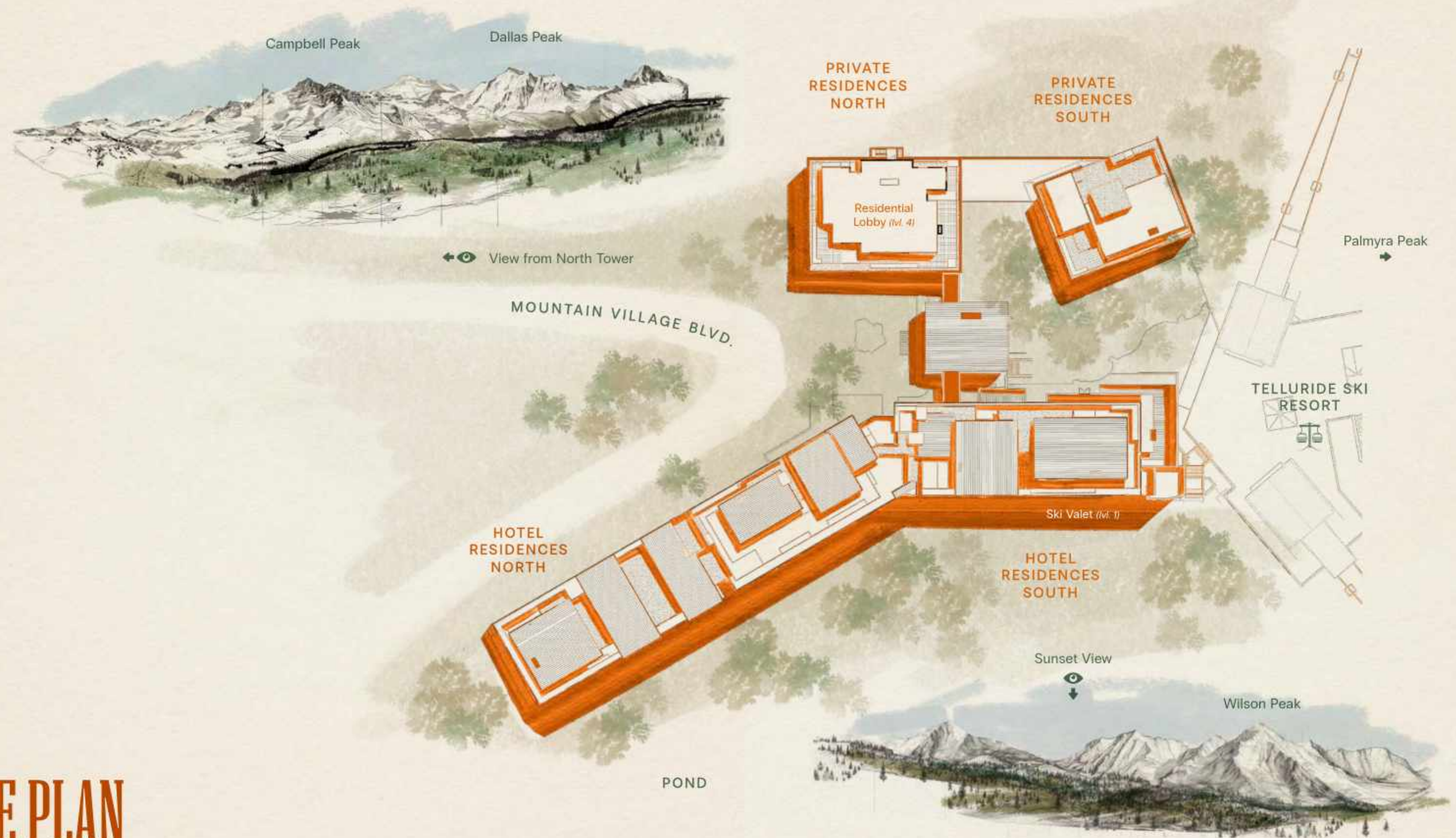
Where Sumptuous Meets Sublime

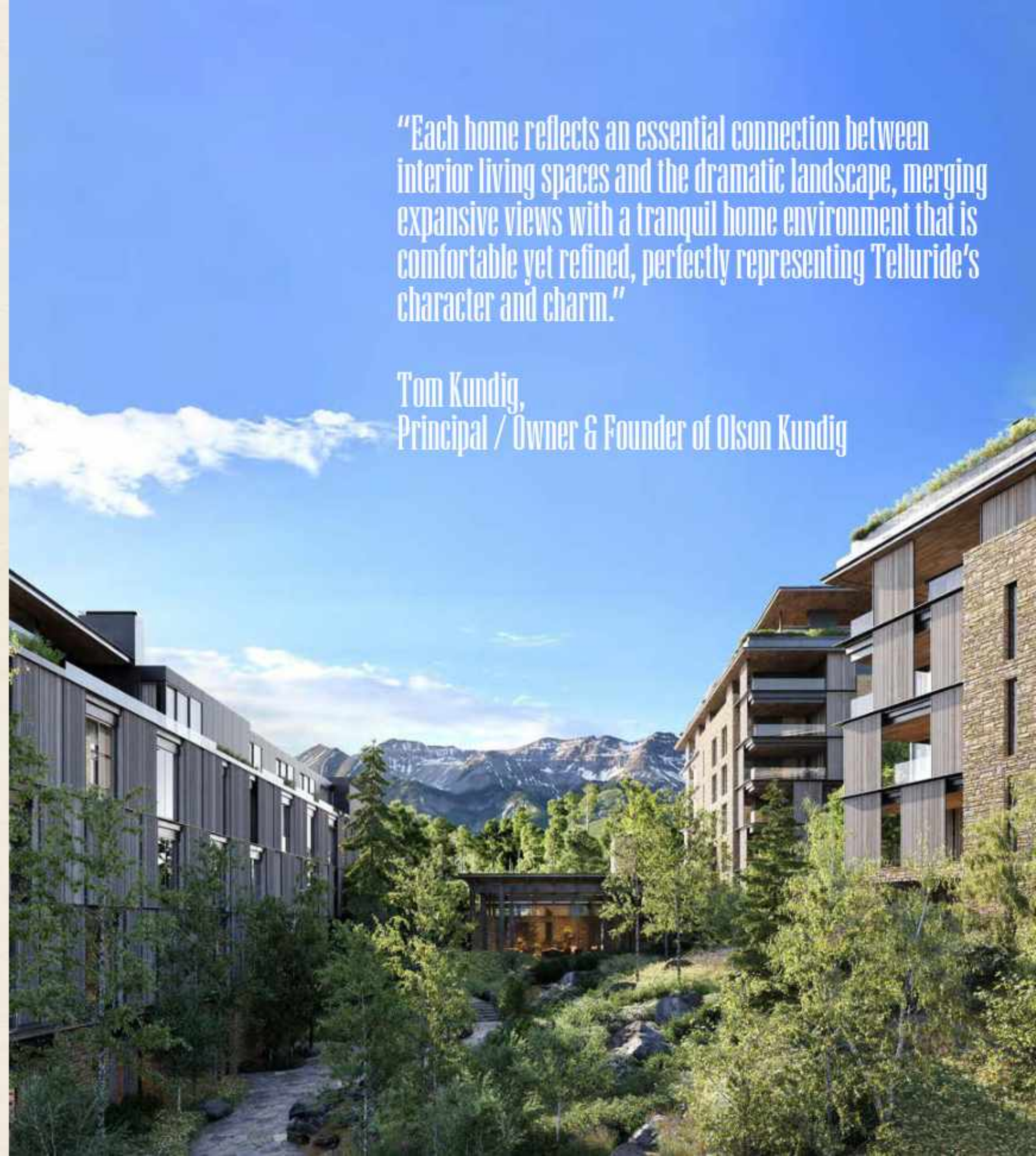

Peak Wellness in the Rockies

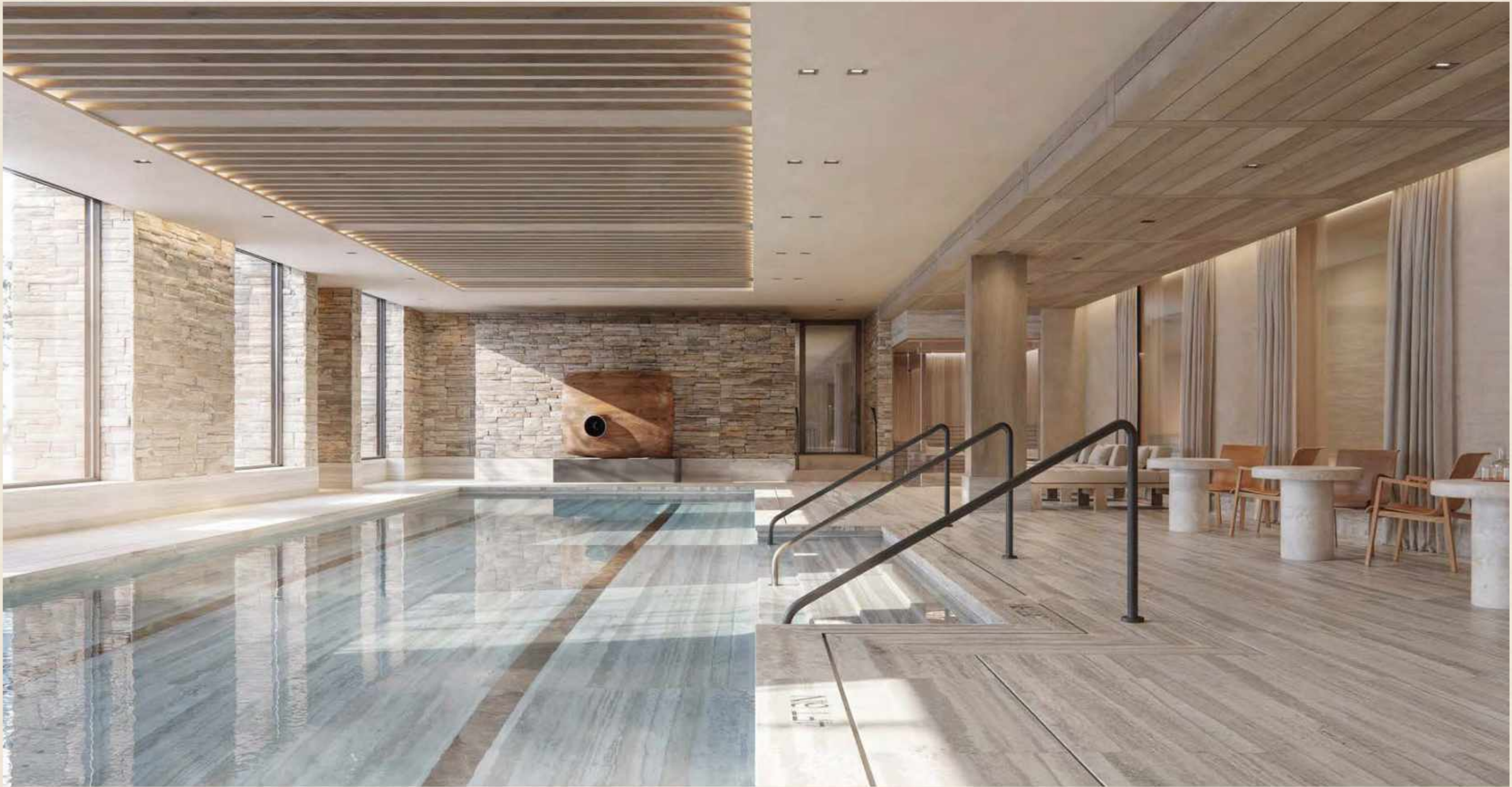

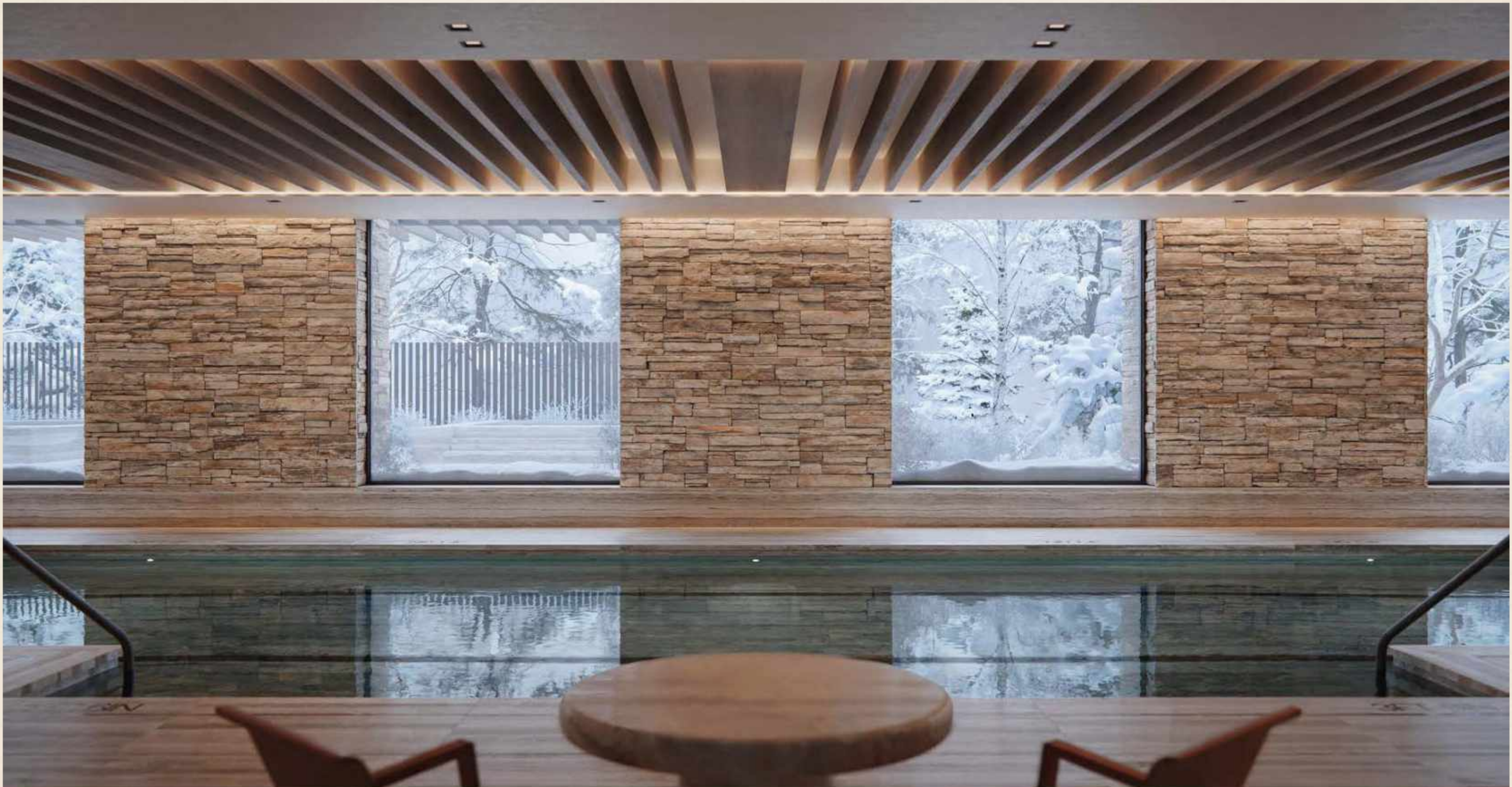

OXYGENATION

Four Seasons Hotel and Residences Telluride is the first resort in North America to provide oxygenated rooms and residences. These progressive systems add oxygen to the air, simulating a lower altitude and providing pristine air quality for all guests and residents. Sleeping and spending time in these spaces results in improved sleep, decreased headache pain, reduced stress, increased energy levels, and overall mental and physical restoration.













SPA

The spa has been designed to draw the outside in, echoing and evoking the majesty of Telluride and connecting residents with their surroundings to maximize the mind-body connection, relaxation, and holistic wellness.

The Thermal Lounge contains a Steam Room, Bio Sauna, and Vitality Spa, all of which serve to detoxify and aid in ridding the body of pollutants, as well as improving circulation, cardiovascular and respiratory health, and muscle relaxation. Additional features such as the Traditional Sauna, Experience Shower, Bucket Shower, and Heated Benches further enhance the thermal experience, offering a variety of ways to unwind and restore balance. The Cold Plunge serves as the yin to the yang of the heat-based treatments, reducing inflammation and increasing metabolism. Just beyond the Thermal Lounge is the Relaxation Lounge, where guests and residents can enjoy the quiet and serenity of the space, or gather around the Outdoor Firepits for a moment of warmth and reflection.

Rugged, Charming, Telluride

Telluride, Colorado, a former prosperous mining town tucked into a Box Canyon at 8,750 feet, has always lured a certain freewheeling, independent spirit — in fact, in 1889, a young Butch Cassidy came here to rob the San Miguel Valley Bank, his first famous heist. Today, this intimate western town is decidedly more laid back. But despite the lowkey atmosphere, this town attracts a very cosmopolitan crowd — from A-list movie stars to designer Ralph Lauren, who owns the Double RL ranch just outside of town.

The closest major regional airport to Telluride is Montrose, about an hour and a half drive away, and there's also Telluride Regional Airport, which is 15 minutes away from town (more convenient for private and charter flights), so it keeps the crowds at bay. The town's 2,500 residents like it that way — it allows Telluride to preserve its small town charm. Locals are proud to tell you that the nearest traffic light is 38 miles away, and the only time there's a bottleneck is when a herd of bighorn sheep are crossing the road.

Colorado Avenue, affectionately referred to as Main Street, is lined with independent shops, cafes, and even a "free box," a community giveaway station.



The Great Outdoors

The 13-minute gondola ride from Telluride to Mountain Village offers a spectacular journey, transporting guests over the ridgeline into the European-style alpine ski resort. Situated just steps away from the property, the gondola provides easy access to the town and market. Much like in the European mountains, the gondola that connects Mountain Village and Telluride serves as the primary mode of transportation for both locals and visitors alike.

With over two extra hours of sunshine in the winter, 2,000 skiable acres, and nearly 150 runs, including impeccably groomed trails, aspen glades, untracked bowls, and narrow chutes dotted with moguls, there is something for everyone.

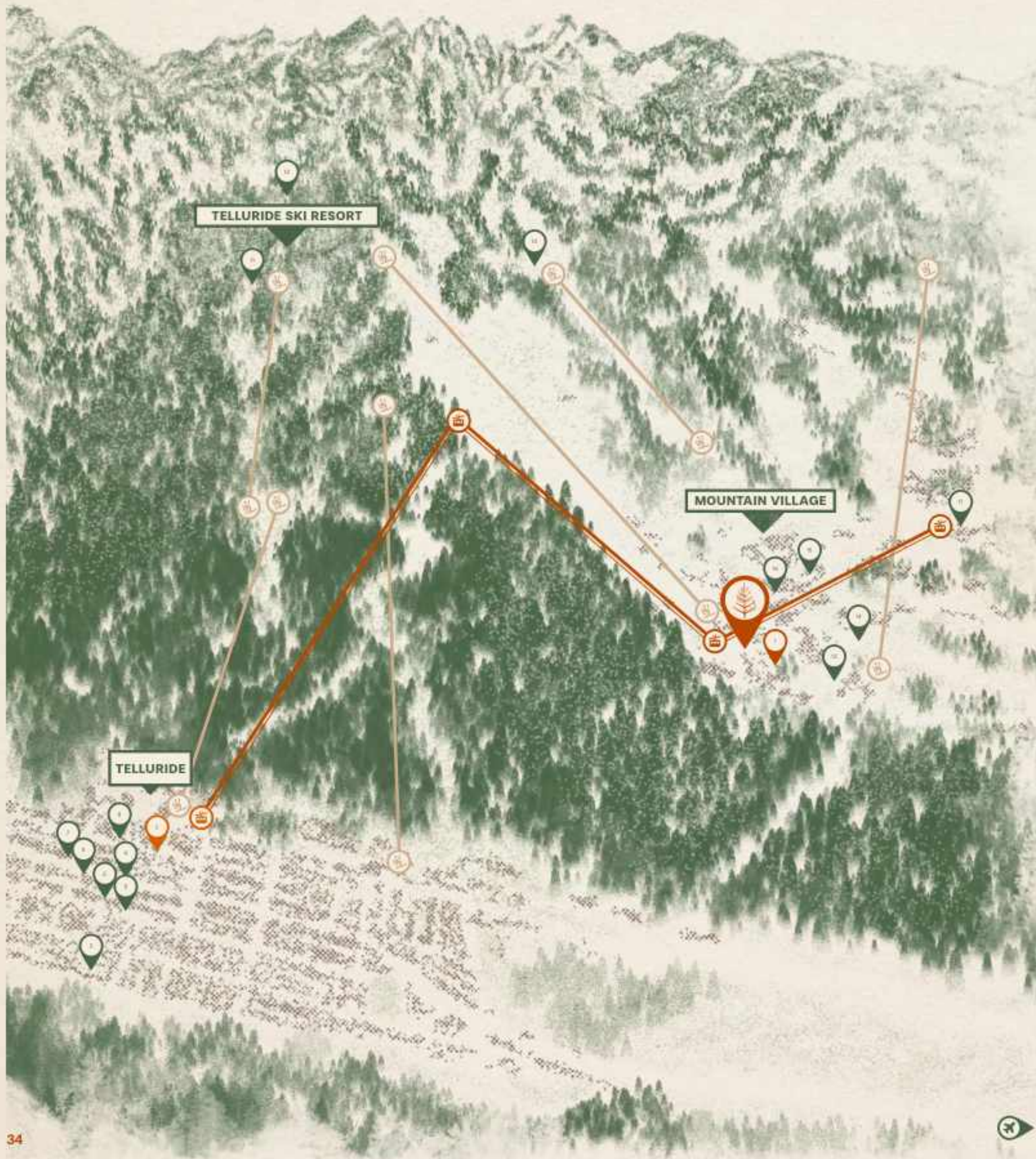
At an elevation of 9,545 feet, this means that the Summer and Fall are equally inviting, and offer pleasant temperatures with mild days and cool evenings. In fact, in recent years, these months have become the most popular, as Mountain Village offers no shortage of activities, from golf, hiking, tennis, mountain biking, and ziplining, to free summer concerts and a farmers' market.
